Attendees will learn when and why low angle rescue techniques should be employed and how to properly set up lowering and raising systems suitable for rescue operations. Instruction will be given on several basic knots and the equipment typically used for low angle rescue. Attendees will set up and execute a low angle rescue and will come away with the knowledge and skill to do so in the future.
