

Directions to instructor: divide class into 6 groups and assign one of the activities below. After 10 minutes regroup for presentations. Bring needed supplies the class may not have such as personal copier to run off the review sheets for each student, alcohol, tweezers, bucket, phone, fake snake !, towels, jewelry to remove, paper cups, baggies, pill bottle, soap, etc

Chapter13 Activities

The following small group activities should take approx 5-10 minutes each to complete.

1. Fill out the Spider and Snake chart and share with class
2. Use the supplies in your pack and on the table to act out the first aid care for snakebite. You may wish to discuss the wilderness tip. You may use chart paper to help as a teaching aid. (pp 373-374)
3. Use the supplies on the table and in your pack to demonstrate tick removal and care of bite. On chart paper, list a few sign/symptoms of Lyme disease and Rocky Mtn. Spotted fever. (pp375-376)
4. Use the supplies on table and in pack to demonstrate care of marine animal injuries listed in the book. (377-378)
5. Demonstrate questioning of a poisoning patient and the gathering of clues (378)
6. Fill out the drug chart (384-386) and share with class.
7. After class presentations, in your small groups do the Poison Match categorizing activity for poisons.
