

Instructor Directions: cut these into individual strips and put into envelop with headings sheet (see next page). Have students put each of the following under the correct heading. Make 4 or 5 sets for small groups.

These poisons include household chemical, medications, alcohol, botulism, and salmonella

Activated charcoal may be used to bind the poison

May want to give this helpful, inky black substance in a covered cup!

Approximately 80% of all poisoning is by this method

These poisons include smoke, industrial gases, CO

The first step is to remove the patient from the contaminated atmosphere (without endangering yourself!)

May cause progressive lung damage even after the person removed from exposure

Oxygen in high rates should be given

These include drugs, bites, and stings

These include poison ivy, acids, alkalis,

Use caution not to contaminate yourself when administrating care

Remove clothing and flood with water for 20+ minutes

When irrigating eyes, the water should run from the \_\_\_\_\_

Do NOT use water when dealing with phosphorus or elemental sodium

The most commonly abused drug
